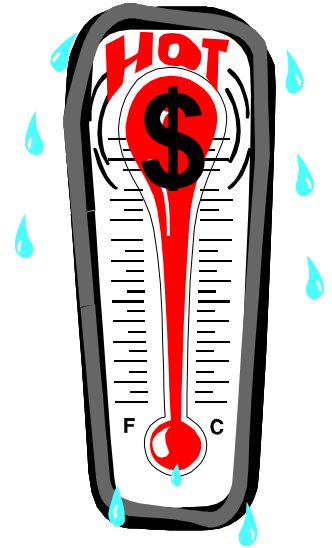

In the last 3 years, NYC power prices have risen almost 30%, and almost doubled over the last decade. Commodity prices (the lion's share of most electric bills) rose 168% over the last year. New policies, such as the ISO's Demand Curve, high natural gas pricing, mandatory Real Time Pricing, and changes to demand response programs could lead to even greater increases. Learn about the impacts such issues could have on your bottom line, and what options could help safeguard your energy budget!
